Key Vocabulary

1	Climate	average weather patterns in a given place over 30 year period.
2	Season	One of the four periods of the year
3	Weather	The state of the atmosphere to describe if it is hot, cold wet, dry, calm stormy, clear, cloudy.
4	Torrents	A strong and fast moving stream of water
5	Weather symbol	A picture to show the weather at that time.
6	Thaw	Unfreeze.
7	Melt	To change from a solid to a liquid by heating.
8	Ocean	A large area of salt water.
9	Continent	A large area of land. (Seven continents).
10	Region	A medium sized area of land of water.
