Admissions FAQ

Do I have to attend church to get a place?

Although church attendance is a higher category than distance, lots of our places are allocated to people at Category 5. Last year (September 2022 cohort) 55% of our places were given to children based on distance.

Can I visit the school?

We run parent tours in November and January. Please contact the school office to book a tour. You will be shown a presentation by the Executive Head/Head of School and taken on a tour of the school, led by our Y6 House Captains. You will also have a chance to talk to our Reception staff team and see the classrooms and surrounding environment.

What happens if I am offered a Reception place?

We hold a New Starters parent meeting in June and Stay and Play sessions in the summer term.

How do you communicate with me?

Communication is really important to us. Once you have accepted your place, we will contact you by letter, phone or email. Having your up-to-date contact details on record is essential.

I am interested in wrap around provision, how does this work?

We have a Breakfast Club and an After School Club, which are run by school staff. Each year we hold back a percentage of places for Reception new starters. We also have outside providers, who run paid for clubs on our premises.

How do I find out more about the school?

Our website has lots of information, especially our newsletters, which give you an overview of our curriculum and special events throughout the year.
