There is a small but consistent number of children, who are arriving late every morning.

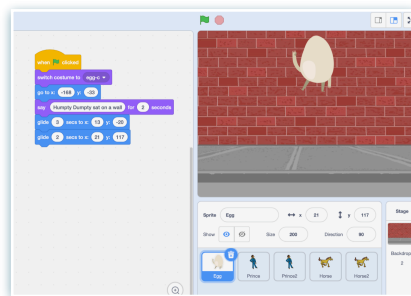

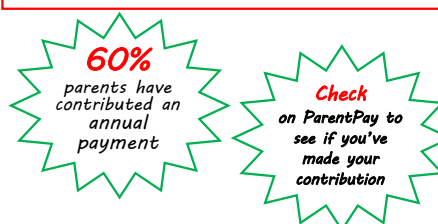
## Governors' Maintenance Fund
