# Registering Interest

We hold a percentage of places from both clubs for Reception children. Places will be offered on a first come first served basis. The first opportunity to register interest in the clubs is Monday 26th June 9:30 a.m. onwards

The form will open at 9:30 a.m. Places will be offered on a first come, first served basis. If you are not offered a place, you will be put on our waiting list.

### Breakfast Club

Our breakfast club runs from **7:45 a.m. until the start of school,** every day during term time, unless there is an INSET day. From 7:45 a.m. onwards, you can drop your child off at the start of the session in the small hall. At the end of the session, children are taken to their class ready for the start of the school day. The children eat breakfast together and then enjoy a wide range of activities; both relaxed activities and more active games too.

Each session costs £4.00 and this includes breakfast which your child will self-select from a choice of cereals, toast and fruit juice. Food intolerance/allergies will be catered for accordingly

#### After School Club

Our after school club runs from **3:30 p.m. to 5:45 p.m.** every day during term time, unless there is an INSET day or early closing. At the end of the school day, children are taken from their class to the club by a nominated teaching assistant. They register on arrival and take part in a wide range of activities; both relaxed activities and more active games too. They also make use of our school facilities including the MUGA, climbing frames and playground.

Each session costs £9.00 and this includes tea which is a sandwich, fruit, juice and water. Food intolerance/allergies are catered for accordingly.

## Key Information

Our clubs are run by a team of school staff; the Club Managers and Club Leaders. Our School Business Manager is responsible for the booking and payment systems. Our Senior Leadership Team oversee the running and management of the clubs.

- We accept voucher schemes for payment
- Refunds for absence/non-attendance will not be given
