1	ON	Salutations and <u>bonjour</u>
2	OU	<u>bonjour</u>
3	OI	Au re <u>voir</u>
4	Guttural "R"	the French 'r' sound. Made from the back of the mouth, not the front.
5	silent letters	The letter 's' is not pronounced in salutations. A lot of final consonants are silent letters. E.g. gris (from previous unit)
6	elision	Je m'appelle. Dropping of the last letter and replacing with an apostrophe. Attaching it to the word that follows which begins with a vowel or mute 'h'.

- 2 Say 'My name is...' in French.
- 3 Ask somebody in French how they are feeling and give a reply to the question.
- 4 Say 'goodbye' and 'see you soon' in French.
