1		sound in livre calculatrice ciseaux
4	Elision	J'habite. Dropping of the last letter of a word (in this case the 'e' in je) and replacing it with an apostrophe. It is attached to the word that follows beginning with a vowel. Je becomes j' as in j'ai. Ne becomes n' as in n'ai
5	Silent letters	The 's' is not pronounced in 'des' The 'x' is also silent in the word 'ciseaux'.

- 1 Say and write in French the nouns and determiners for 12 classroom objects.
- 2 To answer the question 'Qu'est-ce qu'il y a dans ta trousse ?' (What do have in your pencil case?)
- 3 To move from an indefinite determiner (a) to a possessive adjective (my) in French.
- 4 Use the negative response and use all my new knowledge to say what I have/do not have in my pencil case.
