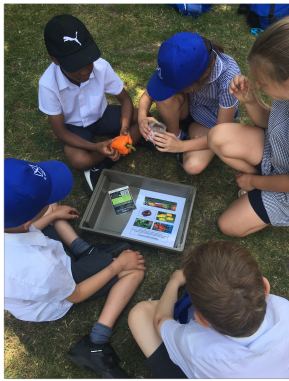

At St. Andrew's, we continue to adapt and improve our curriculum, to enable all children to learn from experiences inside and out of the school grounds. The past two weeks have been very busy, with many year groups taking part in trips and workshops. Our **Year 3** children spent the day at Myddelton House and Gardens, as part of their scientific understanding about plants. This local venue is home to some amazing and unusual local and exotic plants, which the children spent time looking at in great detail.

Our **Year 2** children spent the day at Chalkwell Beach in Essex, this week. The weather was perfect, not too hot but warm enough for the children to have a paddle! For some, it was the first time they had been in the sea and for others, it was a great day for having a fun time with friends. A huge thank you to the Year 2 team for organising the trip and other members of staff, for ensuring everyone had a safe and enjoyable day.
