Represents something, the poppy represents remembering and peace

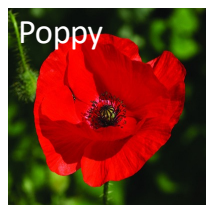
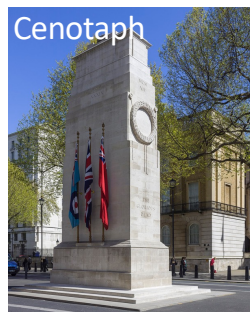
Saints

Dates

All Saints Day- 1st November- A time to remember all the saints

All Souls Day: 2nd November- A time to remember people who have died, particularly those in the past year

Remembrance Day: 11th November; A time to remember people who have died in wars, especially the World Wars

Remembrance Sunday: Sunday nearest Remembrance Day. A time to remember those killed in conflict.
