The stories of these people can change a believer's life too

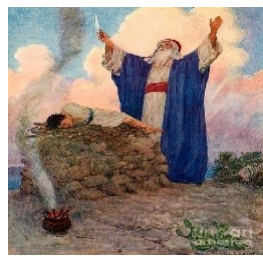

Key Vocabulary

Bible	Holy Book (Scriptures) for Christians
Old testament	First part of the Bible made up from 39 books, shared with Judaism
Faith	A gift from God (trust, obedience, devotion, loyal)
Blessing	A special favour between God and a person
Covenant	Agreement/Promise made between God and a person
Vocation	A strong feeling for a career or occupation
Calling	Following the voice of God
Sacrifice	Making an offering to God
Prayer	Having a conversation with God
Selflessness	More concerned with the needs of others rather than your own

People of the Old Testament

Abraham	He is the father (founder) of faith (Jewish, Christians, Muslims)
Moses	Inspired by God to rescue the Israelites from Egypt
Joshua	Leader of Israelites after Moses
Ruth	A woman who stays with her mother-in-law and a story of sacrifice
