Salvation	To be rescued/saved by God. The relationship between Gid and humankind is restored.
Symbol	A picture linked to a religion or religious idea. (bread, wine, cross)
Last Supper	The last meal that Jesus ate with his disciples.
Holy Communion	A service which recalls the last meal of Jesus that celebrates his death.
Passover/ Pesach	Festival to celebrate the Israelites leaving Egypt.
Forgiveness	To let go of those things that hurt us
Sacrifice	A divine offering
