Key Vocabulary**Salvation**

To be rescued/saved by God. The relationship between God and humankind is restored.

Holy Communion

Liturgical service observed by Christians. It recalls the last meal of Jesus and celebrates his sacrificial death.

Sacrament

An outward sign of an inward grace, bread and wine are sacraments.

Symbol

A representation of a specific religion or religious concept, bread symbolises Jesus' body, the wine symbolises Jesus' blood.

Confession

An admission by a Christian of a wrong doing. Saying sorry to God.

Forgiveness

To let go of those things that hurt us
