Key Vocabulary

Eucharist

The Christian service, ceremony, or sacrament commemorating the Last Supper, in which bread and wine are consecrated and consumed:

Holy Communion

Liturgical service observed by Christians. It recalls the last meal of Jesus and celebrates his sacrificial death.

Sacrament

An outward sign of an inward grace, bread and wine are sacraments.

Symbol

A representation of a specific religion or religious concept, bread symbolises Jesus' body, the wine symbolises Jesus' blood.

Confession

An admission by a Christian of a wrong doing. Saying sorry to God.

Confession

A formal statement that you have done the wrong thing
