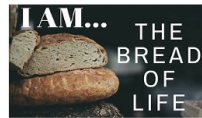

"I am the good shepherd" (John 10:11, 14).



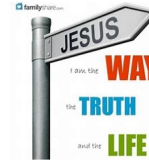
"I am the bread of life" (John 6:35, 41, 48, 51).

Incarnation

God came to live among humans in the form of Jesus

Gospel

Means Jesus birth is 'good news' and he is the example of a relationship between believers and God

Jesus

The second person in the Trinity

Resurrection

Rising from the dead of Jesus after his crucifixion, also the new life of Christians when they follow Christ

Eternal Life

Life that continues beyond this world

Hope

Promised by God, that which He has promised will happen

Truth

Something that is totally reliable. Christian truth is revealed in Jesus Christ
