Police give online safety presentation to Year 6 pupils

This week, we were visited by the Met Police, who came to talk to the children in Year 6 about Online Safety, specifically about apps. They went through popular apps such as *WhatsApp, Instagram, TikTok, YouTube and Snapchat.*

The message given was about age restrictions for these apps, all of which were 13+years, as well as potential risks and harm. The children were then given scenarios to think about, when using these sites. The Police also talked about video games and PEGI ratings, so that our children can be well-informed. After some very sensible questions from the children, they were asked to report back to parents, what they had learned and understood from the workshop. This workshop forms part of our PSHE curriculum content in Year 6, as well as part of the Computing Curriculum about keeping safe online. Finally, the children were told about what to do and who to contact, if they needed to report any inappropriate messages.
