**Important People from the Easter story**

Judas Iscariot	One of the twelve disciples chosen by Jesus. He was in charge of the money bags.
Peter	One of the first disciples chosen and one of Jesus' closest friends. He was a fisherman
The women	These were present at the foot of the cross and had followed Jesus from Jerusalem.
Mary Magdalene	Close friend of Jesus and loyal follower of Jesus

**Key Vocabulary**

<b>Salvation</b>	To be rescued/saved by God. The relationship between God and humankind is restored.
<b>Gospels</b>	First four books of the New Testament
<b>Disciple</b>	A follower of Jesus
<b>Betrayal</b>	To be let down/break of trust between people
<b>Denial</b>	Not owning up to the truth
<b>Forgiveness</b>	To let go of those things that hurt us
<b>Crucifixion</b>	A method of executing criminals
<b>Resurrection</b>	The rising from the dead of Jesus Christ
