

Structures

In Year 2 you made a chair for Baby Bear.



In Year 2 we:

- 1) Generated and communicated ideas using sketching and modelling.
- 2) Made a structure according to design criteria.
- 3) Created joints and structures from paper/card and tape.
- 4) Built a strong and stiff structure by folding paper.
- 5) Tested the strength of own structures.
- 6) Evaluated the strength, stiffness and stability of structure.
- 7) Learnt that shapes and structures with wide, flat bases or legs are the most stable.
- 8) Understood that the shape of a structure affects its strength.
- 9) Learnt that materials can be manipulated to improve strength and stiffness.

Vocabulary which we used in Year 2

Design criteria = a set of rules to help designers focus their ideas and test the success of them.

Structure = something which has been formed or made from parts.

Stable structure = is a structure which does not easily topple over.

Strong structure = is a structure which does not break easily.

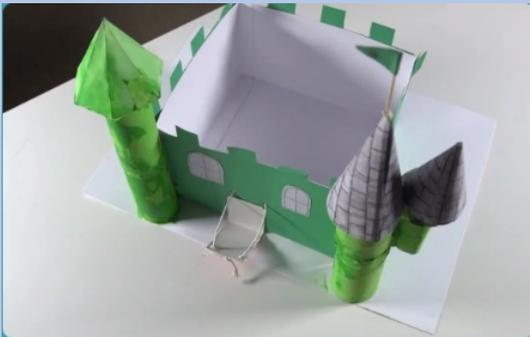
Stiff structure = is a structure or material which does not bend easily.

Weak structure = a structure which is easily broken.

Test = to find out whether something works as it should.

Structures

In Year 3 we will design and make castles



In Year 3 we will:

- 1) Understand that wide and flat based objects are more stable and that strength and stiffness in structures is important.
- 2) Draw a design using 2D shapes and label the 3D shapes that will create the features.
- 3) Construct a range of 3D geometric shapes using nets.
- 4) Evaluate our own and others work based on the presentation / look of the finished product.

Vocabulary which will be new in Year 3:

Structure = something which stands, usually on its own.

Design criteria = a set of rules to help designers focus their ideas and test the success of them.

Feature = . A specific part of something.

Net = a 2D flat shape that can become a 3D shape when assembled.

Strong = it doesn't break easily.

Weak = it does break easily.

Stable = object does not topple over easily.
