Key Vocabulary

borough	a town or urban constituency in Great Britain that sends a member to Parliament
regeneration	regeneration happens when an urban area is upgraded
demographic	The study of a population relating to characteristics such as age, gender, ethnicity.
sustainable	to be able to continue over a period of time
development	any improvement in the standard of living through building and infrastructure
region	an area that has definable characteristics but not always fixed boundaries
community	a group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common
greenbelt	a green area of land near a town that is protected from being developed

FOR	AGAINST
Better quality housing	High costs
Creates job opportunities	Loss of local history and sense of community
Improves desirability to new demographics	Damage to natural habitats and wildlife
Improved transport links	Over population and pollution
