At St. Andrew's School, our results continue to rise in many areas, year on year. We are committed to achieving excellence in all key stages.

No national data has been published yet for 2015, but here are our results.

The national expectation for children at the end of Key Stage Two (Year 6) is Level 4.

Since our 2013 Inspection, our priority has been to raise standards in writing. Our results this year show that we are now well above the national data in Levels 4, 5 and 6 for writing.

This is the last year of levels for all children in Years 1 to 6. New assessments will commence in 2016.

**The year ahead:** In 2015 -2016 we will continue to monitor and support those children who did not achieve a Level 2b in writing at Key Stage One.

We will be reviewing our teaching of Guided Reading and assessment of Reading in Key Stage Two, in line with the new National Curriculum expectations.
