



### **Why do we have a school uniform?**

We believe it is important because:

- A smart uniform gives a child a sense of pride in themselves and the school
- It helps them to feel a part of the school family within the community
- It promotes equality between all children
- It reflects the positive attitude of the school and the children, to those outside.

### **Boys**

- A white shirt (preferably short sleeved)
- Grey school trousers or grey shorts
- A blue V neck jumper with school logo
- A tie (a clip tie may be worn in Reception)
- Grey socks
- Black leather or leather-look shoes (not trainers)
- Flat ankle boots may be worn with trousers

### **Girls**

- A white shirt (preferably short-sleeved)
- A grey skirt, grey pinafore or grey school trousers
- A blue cardigan or V neck jumper with school logo
- A tie (a clip tie may be worn in Reception)
- White or grey ankle or knee length socks
- Navy or grey tights
- Black leather or leather-look shoes (not trainers)
- Flat ankle boots may be worn with trousers
- In summer, a summer dress may be worn (dark blue and white check dress with small gingham style checks)
- A summer playsuit (a shorts-style summer dress in dark blue and white check)
- Boots are not to be worn with dresses or skirts

### **P.E. All children should have**

- A pair of navy shorts (not cycling shorts)
- A house colour polo shirt
- Trainers for outdoor games in Years Reception to Year 6
- Socks needed if girls are wearing tights, as tights need to be removed
- A blue PE bag, with a drawstring cord and school logo, to store the kit in school
- A blue tracksuit in Years Reception to Year 6 (sweatshirt and joggers) during the colder months.

### **Outdoor Wear**

- Dark blue/navy or black coat, raincoat or waterproof. Plain, single colour with no logos but safety reflective strips or armbands are strongly advised

## School Uniform Policy

Reception – Year 6



- Blue fleece jacket with embroidered school crest in white – **optional and for outdoor wear only.** Your child will still need a jumper or cardigan
- School winter hats are available to purchase from Smiths

### Bags

Children in Reception to Year 4 require a blue book bag.

In Years 5 and 6 small blue courier bags/rucksacks may be brought to school.

### Other Details

Apart from small stud earrings in pierced ears, no jewellery should be worn in school. Please be aware that stud earrings should be removed or taped for PE lessons. (Please provide micropore tape if necessary.) Nail varnish, make up and temporary tattoos should not be worn.

Long hair must be tied back with a simple band, ribbon or small slide in school colours – blue or white or blue/white check. Large hair bows or ornate accessories should not be worn.

Girls and boys' hairstyles should be conservative. **No patterns, lines or logos should be shaved into the hair.**

Watches may be worn by children from Y2 upwards. They should be simple analogue watches to help children to tell the time. They will need to be removed for PE. Smart watches may only be worn to tell the time.

All items of clothing and footwear should be clearly labelled.

Items with a logo are available from **Smiths Schoolwear** on Lancaster Road. Ties are available to buy from the school office. We also have samples of summer dresses and the Nursery uniform at the office.

Please note that optional summer uniform relates to the period from about Easter to about October, there are no exact dates for changing. The school may relax the wearing of a tie; particularly during hot weather.
